Who Put the Bomp: Take a nostalgic trip back to 1961 with Barry Mann's upbeat novelty number.

The Beatles in Revue: This medley of classic Beatles hits will bring back fond memories of the 1960s music scene.

Stand By Me: This 1961 single by Ben E. King was featured in the 1986 movie of the same name. (Adrian Emerson, Katy Jones, Robin Trew, Sandy Welch, Joyce Young, *sopranos*; Samantha Flood, Stephanie Klein, *altos*; Jim Heddell, Larry Zafran, *basses*)

I Can't Help Myself: The Motown sound doesn't get any better than this 1965 hit by The Four Tops.

The Very Best of the Beach Boys: This mini-medley features three favorite tunes by the legendary group.

Bridge Over Troubled Water: This song by Simon and Garfunkel was their biggest hit single, and considered their signature song. (Robin Trew, *soprano*; Joan Eastwick, *mezzo-soprano*)

The Silly Sixties (Medley): Rediscover the silly side of the 1960s with this seven-minute medley of nonstop fun!

Do Wah Diddy Diddy: This chart-topper from 1964 by Manfred Mann is the quintessential pop hit for guys.

California Dreamin': This 1966 pop classic by The Mamas and the Papas is on Rolling Stone's top 100 hits of all time.

Love Potion No. 9: This song, released in 1963, was a hit single by The Searchers. (Jim Knopp, *bass*)

Put a Little Love in Your Heart: This song was originally performed in 1969 by Jackie DeShannon.

Both Sides, Now: Written by Joni Mitchell, this song was one of her best known, but was first recorded by Judy Collins in 1967. (Melissa Thirer-Hayward, *soprano*)

Turn! Turn! Turn!: This classic folk rock song by Pete Seeger was a #1 hit for The Byrds in 1965. The lyrics are taken from the book of Ecclesiastes in the Bible.

Hair (Medley): The ground-breaking musical *Hair* gave us many hits—four of which are featured in this medley.

Puff the Magic Dragon (SING-ALONG): This song became a classic after it was recorded in 1963 by Peter, Paul and Mary.
