**Pure Imagination**, written for the 1971 movie *Willy Wonka and the Chocolate Factory*, was sung by the film's star Gene Wilder.

**Singin' in the Rain** is known today as the centerpiece of the 1952 musical film of the same name. Gene Kelly memorably danced to the song while splashing through puddles in a rainstorm.

**Over the Rainbow**: This well-known favorite is a ballad written for the 1939 movie *The Wizard of Oz* and sung by Judy Garland, winning the Academy Award for Best Original Song.

**The Sound of Music (Medley)**: Four favorite melodies from the Rodgers and Hammerstein 1965 movie classic.

**I'll Be There for You**: The original theme song for the sitcom *Friends* (1994-2004) was later re-recorded as this pop song.

**As Time Goes By**: Originally written for a Broadway musical, this song was made famous in the 1943 classic movie *Casablanca*.

**TV Time (Medley)** features theme songs from classic television shows such as *Laverne and Shirley*, *The Brady Bunch*, *Green Acres*, *The Addams Family*, *Happy Days*, and more!

**He's a Tramp**: This song from Disney's animated *Lady and the Tramp* was originally sung by Peggy Lee. (Annie Flood, *soprano*; Samantha Flood, *alto*)

**Hallelujah**: Written by Leonard Cohen, this song increased in popularity after being featured in the animated movie *Shrek*.

**Let's Call the Whole Thing Off**, a Gershwin song from *Shall We Dance*, was performed by Fred Astaire and Ginger Rogers.

**Theme from Ice Castles (Looking Through the Eyes of Love)** is an Academy Award and Golden Globe Award-nominated ballad performed by Melissa Manchester which became the theme song for the 1978 movie *Ice Castles*.

**Thank You for Being a Friend**, written by Andrew Gold, served as the theme for the sitcom *The Golden Girls* (1985-1992).

**Soft Kitty (Theme and Variations)**: This tune was immortalized in pop culture history on the sitcom *The Big Bang Theory*.

**I'm So Glad We Had This Time Together**: The sign-off song from *The Carol Burnett Show* (1967-1978).
