Ain't Misbehavin': Named after the 1929 Fats Waller song, *Ain't Misbehavin'* is a musical revue tribute to the African-American musicians of the Harlem Renaissance of the 1920s and 30s.

The Impossible Dream: This song reminds us that the “quest” to seek out the good in a world of evil emboldens us all.

The Theme from The Pink Panther: One cannot help but smile at this clever arrangement of the jazz/pop classic.

Les Misérables (Medley): In this tale of the French Revolution, the compelling lyrics and haunting melodies bear witness to the strength of the human spirit. Songs include: *At the End of the Day, I Dreamed a Dream, Castle on a Cloud, Do You Hear the People Sing, On My Own, Bring Him Home*
